A funny dog




Many funny dogs**S**

2. **-ies** dopo i sostantivi che terminano in *consonante + y*

baby	bab ies
party	part ies
nationality	nationalit ies

monkey	monkeys

3. **-ves** dopo i sostantivi che terminano in *-f/-fe*

shelf		shel ves
knife		kniv es
wife		wiv es
wolf		wolv es
half		hal ves

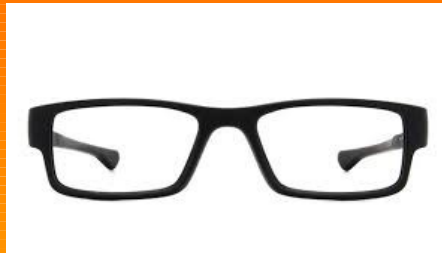
