Present Continuous con significato di futuro

- Si usa per descrivere azioni future certe, programmate e stabilite in precedenza.
- Può essere accompagnato da una data, un orario o da un'espressione di tempo come ***tomorrow, next week, tonight, in an hour*** (vedi sopra).
- In italiano lo traduco di solito con il presente indicativo oppure “dovere + infinito”.
- es. I'm leaving at 11 a.m. tomorrow.
(parto alle 11 domani / devo partire alle 11 domani)

- Forma :

SOGGETTO	VERBO ESSERE	FORMA IN -ING DEL VERBO
I	AM	LEAVING
WE / YOU	ARE	PLAYING
HE / SHE	IS	SITTING
THEY	ARE	STYDYING
